

ATHLETIC TEAMS & PROGRAMS

BOYS' BASKETBALL

Coaches: Ms. Browning & Mr. Payne
Cost: Insurance and KHSAA sports physical
To Join: Try-outs are in December
Information: Season runs January-March.
Criteria: Must complete a try-out application form, have a current physical on file, maintain a 2.0 GPA, and demonstrate appropriate classroom behavior.

CHEERLEADING

Coach: Ms. King
Cost: Purchase of shoes, bodysuits, briefs, hair bows, KHSAA sports physical and athletic insurance.
To Join: Clinics and tryouts are held at the beginning of the school year. Participants will be required to learn a cheer and dance at clinics.
Information: Requirement-Cheer football, girls' basketball and boys' basketball games. Compete in one competition and in the Middle School Showcase.
Criteria: Girls must maintain a 2.0 grade point average and have appropriate behavior.

CROSS COUNTRY

Cost: \$40
To Join: Must be able to run long distance (2.5 miles)

To Join: Tryouts are at the end of July.
Information: Season runs August-October.
Criteria: Have a current physical on file, maintain a 2.0 GPA and have appropriate classroom behavior.
